Con Suite times are approximate, and may be started a bit sooner, or later, depending on basic Con Suite needs. Remember that the Con Suite is intended to be a source of food between meals during Marcon, and not as your sole source of food. We suggest that you eat at least one full meal each day during Marcon. There are several places to eat in the Food Court on the first floor, and there are several nearby restaurants.
